# **Handbook Reminder: Medication Administration Policy**

- No school employee is permitted to administer, or supervise a student's selfadministration of, any prescription or non-prescription medication without a completed and signed School Medication Authorization Form on file from the student's parent or guardian.
- Only the individual(s) designated by the principal are authorized to dispense medication, and only in accordance with the prescribing physician's orders.
- Every instance of medication administration must be **recorded in the official medication log**, which is maintained in the school office.
