We would like to announce a few changes for the 2024-25 school year. Mrs. McQueen will be leaving at the end of the school year to spend more time with her family. With only 20 students in 4th grade next year, Mrs. Wellenkamp will move to 3rd grade and Mrs. Davis will be the sole 4th grade teacher. We are hiring another 2nd grade teacher to join Mrs. Gibson.

BOWLING: Congratulations to our Girls' bowling team on their 5th place finish at the IESA Bowling Sectional tournament in Peoria. The 5th place finish qualified the team for this week's State Tournament in Joliet. Good luck girls!

Our Boys' bowling team placed 7th out of 17 teams and barely missed out on qualifying for state as a team. The 7th place team finish is the highest team finish at Sectional competition in program history.

Individually, Caden C and Korbin M advanced to the State Tournament in Joliet. Caden placed 3rd out of 80 bowlers with a three game series of 571. In addition, Caden bowled a 226 game to set a new school record for highest score in a single game. Korbin placed 22nd overall and advanced as an individual bowler with a 437 series. Both Caden and Korbin bowled well above their regular season scoring averages. Good luck to both of you at the State tournament.
